#### **Business**

Minutes AGM 2016 accepted.

Accounts presented and agreed. Questions were asked regarding costs around 'coaching', 'other' and 'debtors'.

The club has done a little better this year collecting in outstanding debt and there is still some coming in.

The fees are not going up this year but will definitely increase again next season. At this present moment it is not known by how much as it will depend on turnover.

Club house – plans have gone to the Council for an informal chat. Cricketers believe they can raise their half of the cost of the clubhouse OK. Predicted costs are £1.5M. Cost of getting plans through planning will be about £50,000. Ground rent for the new clubhouse will be the same as the rent for the current one – £4,500 per year. The lease will be for 99 years. The land is only Council owned so this will not be as complicated as getting the pitches built but a planning consultant will be needed and the club will need to employ someone soon.

Current clubhouse will be open on Sunday mornings for breakfast servings. Timings will coincide with junior training to encourage parents to come over for coffee and bacon! 9am – 12pm

There are no U14 girls' teams as they are playing in the Gulls or Starlings on Saturday in development league.

J. Royce going into schools to try and recruit more junior players. Analysis of numbers and ages means he can target those age groups. At present he is targeting U10s as numbers are low in this age group.

Brighton and Hove High School has emailed the club wishing to get more involved with us.

Member suggestion – get a couple of banners made to put around the pitches advertising the new clubhouse and the club in general.

Member suggestion – can the ST be 5 free games as opposed 4. Cost analysis needs to be done.

Member comment/request – There are so many products on Pitchero for subs that members do not know which product to pick. Can members be allocated to a product so they pay the right amount?

Any special cases need to be discussed with the appropriate club captain.

Member request – please can we have bigger print on the P & L accounts as it is too small to read. This has been requested before.

## **CC** reports
