



The following will be the BHHC100 Club Rules:

1. The "100 Club" will be operated under The Gambling Act 2005, which deals with a Small Society Lottery. The promoter will be the Chairman, Brighton and Hove Hockey Club
2. The Club reserves the right to alter the Rules of the "100 Club" from time to time, as may be necessary. A copy of the current Rules will be available on our website: www.brightonandhovehockeyclub.net
3. All profits made by the "100 Club" will be used to support the Club and its objectives
4. The Lottery will be limited to 100 members of Brighton and Hove Hockey Club over the age of 16 years (but see also paragraph 12).
5. The subscription will be £5 per month, payable by Standing Order on the 1st day of each month. On receipt of a Standing Order form, the applicant will be allocated the next available Draw Number. For each additional £5 paid per month an additional Draw Number will be allocated.
6. A draw will take place on the 3rd Saturday of every month for cash prizes (except for the super draw). Winners of prizes will be notified and the results of the draw will be open for inspection and published on our website.
7. The draws will be conducted by 3 people, one of whom will be the Chairman of the Club (or in his absence the Vice Chairman) in order to ensure the draw is fair.
8. The 100 club administrator will ensure that no "100 Club" participant will be included in the draw if the appropriate subscription has not been received by the 5th working day of the month in which the draw is taking place. The promoter reserves the right to reallocate any Draw Number where payment has not been received on time.
9. Prizes will be paid by cheque which will be sent through the post and only to the person holding the winning number.
10. In the event of there being less than 50 participants, prizes shall be halved.
11. In the event of there being more than 100 applications to join the "100 Club", the Club will issue the required number of Draw Numbers to satisfy demand and prizes will be awarded on a pro rata basis of the actual number of members at the time of the draw.
12. Participants can cancel their entry in the Lottery at any time by giving one month's written notice to the Treasurer and by informing their bank. Any decision by Brighton and Hove Hockey Club to wind up the "100 Club" will also be by one month's written notice. Under no circumstances can any payments be refunded.

Additional "Super Draw" 100 Club Rules

- Super draw to be in April/May at planned Presidents Day match (ideally on Dinner-Dance weekend)
- For season 2010-11 100-club members must be signed & paying before Christmas in order to be entered in the Super draw
- From season 2011-12 onwards members must be signed & paying before the end of September in order to be entered in the Super draw
